

Between the 3rd and 9th centuries, the Mayans built hundreds of impressive pyramids. El Castillo de Chichen Itza, situated in the Yucatan peninsula, is a perfect example. This pyramid built with stones and a powerful mortar possesses a much sharper angle than any other built in Egypt. Its nine-tier architecture includes four staircases that narrow out bringing ones attention to the altar at the top. The pyramid has precisely 365 steps, one for each day of the year. With its square base, it measures 180 feet (55 metres) across, 79 feet high (24 metres) and covers 32,258 square feet (3,000 square metres). The Temple's sanctuary which sits at the top of the pyramid, welcomed priests that conducted the religious rituals, that once included human sacrifices. In 1930, archaeologists were surprised in finding a smaller, older temple inside the Chichen Itza Pyramid. This temple measured 98 feet (30 metres) across and was 52 feet (16 metres) tall. Its presence clearly shows that some pyramids were enlarged in the course of history and would become bigger with each new regime.

The rich Mayan civilisation was spread through modern day Mexico, Belize, Guatemala and Honduras. This gifted nation outdid itself in architecture, mathematics and astronomy. This essentially urban civilisation erected such famous cities as: Palenque, Tikal and Chichen Itza, a 740 acres (300 hectares) city. Sadly, there are only three original manuscripts left that would permit study of the ideograms of Mayan writings. The Spaniards had destroyed them in belief that they were the Devil's work. Today, there are about two million descendants of the Mayan people who still live principally in Mexico and Guatemala.

A Lost Civilisation!


In the 9th century, Mayan civilisation declined drastically. It was thought that an epidemic or a natural disaster wiped them out, but this is not the case. The Mayans, who were agricultural nomads, would simply abandon the village once the ground was no longer fertile. Wars that broke out during the 15th century were what finally led to the demise and ruin of these grand cities.







IMPORTANT NOTICE

Some models may contain some red-dot pieces, they are not part of your Puzz-3D®. You should set these pieces aside while you attempt your 3 dimensional adventure. CAREFUL!!! DO NOT THROW AWAY ANY RED DOT PIECES UNTIL YOUR PUZZLE IS COMPLETED. Frequently, small red-dot pieces are still attached to puzzle pieces. A quick check on the under side to see if there are skeleton cuts would be most prudent.

HELPFUL HINTS

Handling the puzzle pieces may cause static electricity which could make them cling to your clothing. Keep your puzzle away from infants and house pets. Animals love to chew the foam pieces and this may cause choking. Please note however, that they are non-toxic. In order to preserve your puzzle, keep away from intense heat such as radiators and the sun. This may cause warping and color fading.

Although Wrebbit Inc. guarantees the quality of its products, our Customer Service Department is there to help you in any way needed. Should anything happen to a piece of your Puzz-3D®, simply send us this technical drawing with the area circled where the problem is occurring. Do not forget to write down your name and address along with your telephone number (and area code).

Remember to check thoroughly through your bag of discarded red-dot pieces to determine if any good puzzle pieces are still attached.

Allow 4 to 6 weeks for Customer Service to process your request.

Cela pourrait endommager votre puzzle et/ou causer la décoloration de l'illustration.
